Steps Toward Successful Completion of Second Language Acquisition Academies and TExES ESL Certification



1. Attend three Saturday trainings at SFA
 - September 26, 2009 McKibben 131 8:00-3:30
 - October 10, 2009 McKibben 131 8:00-3:30
 - October 24, 2009 McKibben 131 8:00-3:30
2. Register for the TExES ESL Supplemental **154** exam
 - *Register for and pay for the October 31, 2009 paper-based test (PBT) by **October 2, 2009***
OR
 - *Register for and pay for a computer-based test between October 27 and November 7, 2009 by **October 2, 2009.***
AND
 - Mail, fax, email, or give your admission ticket to Mary Catherine Niño or Cynnamon Hines by **November 1, 2008** for reimbursement of fee (\$120)
3. Take and pass the TExES ESL Supplemental 154 exam
 - Mail, fax, email, or give a copy of your passing score to Mary Catherine Niño or Cynnamon Hines to receive certification fee (\$77)
4. Apply for ESL Supplemental Certification with SBEC
 - Mail, fax, email, or give a copy of your passing score to Mary Catherine Niño or Cynnamon Hines to receive your ENLACE stipend (\$300)

Computer-Administered Testing at SFA

- You must arrive at the test center 30 minutes prior to the start time on your admission ticket.
- The testing center is located in the Rusk Building, Room 328. The Rusk Building is across from the Baker Patillo Student Center, close to the cul-de-sac at the intersection of Vista and Alumni Drive.
- To avoid a parking ticket, you must get a visitor's parking permit from UPD or from the Information Booth on Vista Drive.
- The testing center will provide scratch paper and pencil. You will not be allowed to bring any items into the testing room.
- You will be provided a locker upon arrival to store your purse, wallet, keys, etc.
- You may wear a jacket, but you must have it on when you enter the room (you cannot carry a jacket in with you). The testing room is usually quite cold.

****You will register for the Computer-administered test with ETS. SFA only *administers* the CAT.****

SFA administers the TExES at Kennedy Auditorium, located across from the Baker Patillo Student Center, close to the Stone Fort.

On the Day of the Test

- Bring your admission ticket.
- Bring identification in the *same name as the admission ticket*.
- Review the id requirements in the Registration Bulletin. Identification must be current, not expired with photograph and signature. Valid driver's license and passports are acceptable forms of identification; student identification is not acceptable.
- For the paper-based test, bring 3-4 soft-lead (No. 2 or HD) pencils with good erasers. Mechanical pencils and mechanical erasers cannot be used.
- Dress so that you can adapt to any room temperature. (Kennedy Auditorium is usually very, very cold!)
- DO NOT BRING YOUR CELL PHONE.
- DO NOT BRING ANY OTHER PERSONAL ITEMS.
- DO NOT BRING EXTRA PAPER. (The testing center will provide scratch paper to CAT takers. PBT takers can use space in the test booklet for scratch paper if necessary.)
